

KYRIAKO BOW PRIVACY POLICY

Kyriako Bow (Kyriako Bow Ties) has created this privacy statement in order to establish our firm commitment to your privacy and security in compliance with the *Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act* (“*PIPEDA*”) and the National Standard of Canada model code for the protection of personal information. This document defines Kyriako Bow’s practices in regard to the collection of visitor information from this website. This document only applies to the Kyriako Bow site <http://www.kyriakobow.com/>

SECTION 1 - WHAT DO WE DO WITH YOUR INFORMATION?

The types of Personal Information that Kyriako Bow may collect about you includes your name, home address, business address, telephone number and personal e-mail address. Other information that may be collected is billing/account information, shipping and freight information, or measurements pertaining to the sizing of garments to be made or shipped to an individual. This information will only be collected with prior notice and only with the consent of the individual. When you submit your personal information to Kyriako Bow we respect your privacy and do not share this information [except to the extent required by the laws of Canada or if you need to send information offsite]. Upon your written request, subject to certain exceptions in compliance with *PIPEDA*, Kyriako Bow will inform you of the use and disclosure of your Personal Information and will give you access to that information. Access requests should be sent to our head office, using the contact information below. If you at any time decide that you would like us to remove any or all of your Personal Information from our database, simply contact us by email at info@kyriakobow.com or in writing to our head office using the contact information below.

When you purchase something from our store, as part of the buying and selling process, we collect the personal information you give us such as your name, address and email address.

When you browse our store, we also automatically receive your computer’s internet protocol (IP) address in order to provide us with information that helps us learn about your browser and operating system.

With your permission, we may send you emails about our store, new products and other updates.

Mailing List

You may choose to join our mailing list. When you submit your email address to use we assume that you want to be contacted regarding promotions, newsletters, and offers at Kyriako Bow. Occasionally, we may send e-mail communications to you with information about the services of Kyriako Bow and other third parties with whom we have a relationship. When you join our mailing list we respect your privacy and do not share your address. If you at any time decide that you don't want to receive any forthcoming mailings, simply email us at info@kyriakobow.com with subject heading “Unsubscribe” and we will remove you from our mailing list.

SECTION 2 - CONSENT

How do you get my consent?

When you provide us with personal information to complete a transaction, verify your credit card, place an order, arrange for a delivery or return a purchase, we imply that you consent to our collecting it and using it for that specific reason only.

If we ask for your personal information for a secondary reason, like marketing, we will either ask you directly for your expressed consent, or provide you with an opportunity to say no.

How do I withdraw my consent?

We may disclose your personal information if we are required by law to do so or if you violate our Terms of Service.

SECTION 4 - WIX.COM

Payment:

All payments, charges, and return/exchange offers are made through PayPal Inc. and through Stripe Inc. for credit card transactions, for the most security and protection to our customers and to ourselves. In order to make a purchase you must have a PayPal account or a valid credit card in order to process your order. For more information on how your payments are protected, we suggest you visit PayPal Inc.'s Terms of Use and Privacy Policy, and for more information on PayPal Inc.'s purchase protection please visit PayPal Inc.'s Security page. We also suggest that you visit Stripe Inc.'s Terms of Use and Privacy Policy on how your information may be stored or used in processing credit card transactions.

If you choose a direct payment gateway to complete your purchase, then Wix.com stores your credit card data. It is encrypted through the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI-DSS). Your purchase transaction data is stored only as long as is necessary to complete your purchase transaction. After that is complete, your purchase transaction information is deleted.

All direct payment gateways adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover.

PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of credit card information by our store and its service providers.

SECTION 5 - THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

In general, the third-party providers used by us will only collect, use and disclose your information to the extent necessary to allow them to perform the services they provide to us.

However, certain third-party service providers, such as payment gateways and other payment transaction processors, have their own privacy policies in respect to the information we are required to provide to them for your purchase-related transactions.

For these providers, we recommend that you read their privacy policies so you can understand the manner in which your personal information will be handled by these providers.

SECTION 6 - SECURITY

To protect your personal information, we take reasonable precautions and follow industry best practices to make sure it is not inappropriately lost, misused, accessed, disclosed, altered or destroyed.

Our store is hosted on Wix.com Inc. They provide us with the online e-commerce platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you.

Wix.com Inc. has implemented security measures designed to protect the Personal Information you share with us, including physical, electronic and procedural measures. Among other things, Wix.com offers HTTPS secure access to most areas on our Services; the transmission of sensitive payment information (such as a credit card number) through our designated purchase forms is protected by an industry standard SSL/TLS encrypted connection; and Wix.com Inc. regularly maintains a PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards) certification. COOKIES
